GETTING STARTED

The City of Minot is embarking on a new process to update the Comprehensive Plan. A Comprehensive Plan is long-range vision, guide and design for the community's future. It serves as a guide for elected officials to use when making decisions and is the legal foundation for rules and regulations adopted by the community, such as the zoning ordinance and subdivision regulations. Updating the Comprehensive Plan is an important step in determining how the City desires to guide land use, plan for new growth and the rate of new growth. In addition, this plan will update supporting system plans including transportation, infrastructure and public facilities.

The Comprehensive Plan process has five phases: (1) Initiation and Analysis (2) Visioning and Goals/Policy Setting (3) Alternatives (4) Draft Plan Preparation (5) Final Plan Preparation and Council review and approval.

MINOT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN STEERING COMMITTEE HOLDS KICK-OFF MEETING

On August 25th, the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee held its first meeting. The committee heard a brief presentation from Bonestroo, the City's consultants, on what they can expect during the process to update the Comprehensive Plan.
