- Minot's application submitted
- HUD will review applications for 90 days
- Final announcement (January 2016)
- Project Details include:
 - Affordable housing for vulnerable populations in new micro-communities
 - Community Facilities and Public Gathering Spaces
 - Greenway from Roosevelt Park to Oak Park
 - Improved water management and communication network
 - Construction will begin in 2016
- Minot submitting 100 Resilient Cities application week of 1 December.

Water Issues

NAWS Projects:

- Preliminary design is underway to expand the Minot plant capacity to 30MGD.
- Expected time for design is 14-18 months.

Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS)

- Public comments addressed and reviewed by the Bureau of Reclamation, State Water Commission, city of Minot and other cooperating agencies.
- The Final SEIS was published in April 2015
- The Record of Decision (ROD) was signed August 21, 2015
- The Administrative Record should be ready to be filed with the Federal Court in November
- The litigating attorneys are working on a briefing schedule

- Grand Opening (6 May 2016)


