# NDRC

- Minot's application submitted
- HUD will review applications for 90 days
- Final announcement (15-31 January 2016)
- Project Details include:
  - Affordable housing for vulnerable populations in new micro-communities
  - Community Facilities and Public Gathering Spaces
  - Greenway from Roosevelt Park to Oak Park
  - Improved water management and communication network
  - Construction will begin in 2016
- Minot submitted 100 Resilient Cities application submitted
- 100 Resilient Cities Results in April 2016

# Downtown Parking

- Downtown Parking
  - Renaissance Ramp - 1 level opened on December 15<sup>th</sup>
    - Gravel ramp access off of 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue
    - Approximately 30 spaces available (Full completion ~30 January 2016)
  - Renaissance Development will begin early 2016
  - Central Ramp continues on schedule (Completion April 2016)
  - Parking equipment installation (February & May 2016)
