### Parking Structures


- Renaissance final completion work advancing rapidly. Will be fully open between Feb 8-15<sup>th</sup>

### 6<sup>th</sup> St Underpass Pump Station


- Building fully enclosed



The Minot Police Department continues to see an annual increase in calls for service. The department responded to 40,127 calls in 2015 which is over a 7 percent increase from 2014 and up 32% since 2010.

- The assessor's office has completed mailing out all applications for qualifying exemptions and homestead credits for senior citizens.




# Airport


