
Public Works LCIR

- The first public input meeting on the MREFPP was held on June 30 at Perkett school gymnasium.
- Over 500 postcards were mailed to residents notifying them of the input meeting for phases 2 and 3 of the flood protection project (Napa Valley and Forrest road reaches)
- There were over 160 citizens who attended the public input meeting.



Phase II Resilience Planning Department Application

- Minot is one of 40 communities and states to move forward to Phase II, selected by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the National Disaster Resilience Competition.
- We now have the opportunity to further refine Minot's needs and develop specific projects and programs to expedite our recovery and advance our goals of becoming a more resilient city and region in the future.
- Community Advisory Committee meeting on Monday, July 13, from noon to 2:30 p.m. in room 201 of the Minot Municipal Auditorium, to kick off the next round.
- Resiliency Academy 20-22 July (Denver, CO)
- Next submittal to HUD by the 27 October 15 deadline.



City Assessor's LCIR

- City Assessor Professionals have reviewed approximately 300 homes in the Souris River Valley (May-June 2015).
- ~ 2500 homes in the valley will be reviewed in 2016.
- ~50% of the homes have been notified by letter requesting an appointment. The remaining half of the letters should be going out over the next couple of weeks.
- Appraisers are also measuring and assessing new homes and residential & commercial structures once completed in 2016.


- Auditorium Events – June/July

- Downtown Infrastructure Project
 - Rain and minor construction issues have caused a delay of about 2 weeks.
 - Concrete paving on Central Ave will begin soon
 - Work starting around Central Campus to complete by Aug 15

Infrastructure Development Update

- Downtown Parking Structures
 - Construction on Central Ramp happening rapidly. Tower crane installation starts July 15th.
 - Construction on Renaissance continuing on a good pace. Expected completion on target for end of year.

Airport LCIR

- Terminal Construction
 - Construction 79% complete
 - Sheetrock being installed
 - Specialty windows being installed
 - Canopy installation continues
 - Approx. 75 workers daily
- Apron and Parking Lot projects

 - Phase II Parking started
- Airport Master Plan pending contract, will begin in July
