



GARBAGE COLLECTION ROUTES AND SCHEDULE

Residential garbage is collected by the City of Minot's Sanitation Department twice a week, as follows:

1. Tuesday and Friday collection for residences located north of 11th Avenue SW, north of 31st Ave. NE and west of Broadway.
2. Monday and Thursday collection for all other residential areas.



GARBAGE MUST BE SET OUT BY 7:00 A.M. ON THE DAY OF COLLECTION TO INSURE PICKUP! SCHEDULED PICKUP DAYS

COLLECTION FEES

A monthly charge of \$10.18 per dwelling unit is added to each resident's water bill. This amount includes the cost of collection of all residential garbage and the cost of burying that garbage in the City of Minot's Landfill. Fees are based upon the current operating budget and are adjusted periodically to reflect the cost of service.

COLLECTION LOCATIONS

• STREET COLLECTION

Garbage must be placed within 5 feet of the curb or pavement edge. Garbage may not be placed for collection prior to 6:00 p.m. the day before collection. Containers must be removed from the collection point before 10:00 p.m. the day of collection.

• ALLEY COLLECTION

Garbage must be placed within six feet of the alley in a place where access is not impeded by a fence or other obstruction.

• *WINTER COLLECTION*

During winter and heavy snow conditions garbage must be placed on the corner of the driveway, free from obstructions and accessible to the crews.

• CONTAINERS

Household waste must be contained in plastic bags, boxes or cans. Trash cans are to be made of metal or plastic, have tapered sides, and handles suitable for lifting and dumping. Lids must be removable, and not fastened to the container in any way. **The maximum capacity of the container cannot exceed 34 gallons. Weight must not exceed 50 pounds.**

SPECIAL WASTES

• **Ashes:** DO NOT mix ashes with garbage. Only cold ashes will be picked up. Ashes must be placed in a closed plastic bag and set a few feet away from the other garbage.

• **Paint/Paint Cans:** Empty paint cans or empty solvent containers will be picked up by crews. Paint will be picked up if cement powder or kitty litter is mixed with it to form a solid mass. From **April 18th to October 1st**, liquid paint can be taken to the Household Hazardous Waste drop at the landfill.

• **Motor Oil:** Motor oil will NOT be picked up by crews; however, it will be accepted at the landfill. A special receptacle is set up for used oil.

• **Car Batteries:** Batteries will NOT be picked up by crews. Many retailers accept old car batteries when you purchase a new one. This item will also be accepted at the Landfill HHW building.

• **Animal Waste:** Animal waste should be placed in sealed plastic bags before placing in cans.

• **Medical Waste:** Place your used syringes, lancets, and like materials in a puncture resistant container (like a sealed empty liquid detergent bottle).

• **Sharp Objects:** Place broken glass, sharp metal pieces or any other sharp items in a puncture resistant container.

ROLL-OFF CONTAINER

If you have an excessive amount of both demolition and household waste, the Public Works Department will provide a roll-off. This container is offered for City garbage collection patrons only. To receive this service, contact the City of Minot Public Works Department for scheduling by calling 857-4140. The charge for this is \$75 per dump.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

City crews do not pick up construction debris. All waste generated will be the responsibility of the contractor or occupant.

FLOOD DEBRIS

Post flood debris is the responsibility of the homeowner or contractors.

RENTAL AND INVESTMENT PROPERTIES

All construction, demolition debris, along with bulk items left behind by tenants at an investment/rental property is the responsibility of the property owner and cannot be placed on the curb for pick up by sanitation crews.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

The City of Minot will sponsor an annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program with the location to be announced. Tentative dates are May 20th and 21st from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. both days. All household hazardous waste not normally picked up by the sanitation crews may be brought to this program free of charge for City of Minot residents only. PERMANENT HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS

WASTE DROP

The household hazardous waste drop off and exchange facility, at the landfill will be open during normal landfill hours, from **April 18th - October 1st**. The facility will collect paint, stains, varnishes, solvents, oil, pesticides, herbicides, car care products, and household cleaning products free of charge for City garbage collection patrons only. Collected items deemed suitable for reuse will be available, free of charge, to persons wanting them.

YARD WASTE (Compost)

The City DOES NOT collect yard waste with its collection crews. If you wish to dispose of yard waste, you can haul it to the City of Minot Landfill, free of charge, or haul the yard waste to one of the ten compost sites located around the City of Minot (the sites are illustrated on the map). DO NOT mix yard waste with household garbage.

These compost sites are for City of Minot garbage collection patrons only and are not to be used by non-residents or by commercial haulers. Yard waste includes grass clippings, garden waste, leaves, vines, flowers, and flower bed clippings.

MULCHING

Grass clippings returned to the lawn provide up to 25 percent of your lawn's total fertilizer needs. Clippings contain about 4 percent nitrogen, 2 percent potassium, and 1 percent phosphorus. While decomposing, they also serve indirectly as a food source for the bacteria in the soil, which are doing many beneficial things (such as decomposing thatch) for a healthy turf environment.

BRANCHES AND TREE TRIMMINGS

Only trees and hedge trimmings cut by the homeowner will be picked up curbside. Branches must be cut and bundled in no more than 6 ft. lengths. Logs must be no larger than 10" in diameter or 50 lbs. in weight. Stumps must be separated from branches. If the superintendent deems the pile to be excessive a rolloff will be provided for \$75 per dumping. **Trees cut by anyone other than the homeowner will not be hauled by the City.**

WOOD WASTE / USE

All citizens of Minot are highly encouraged to utilize as much wood product/trees as possible before being placed on the curb for disposal. Firewood is "FREE" for all citizens of the city proper and is to be found at the City Landfill during normal operating hours. Firewood must be cut and loaded by you, the citizen. (City of Minot is not liable for accidents.) Please stop at the scale house for directions to and from this area. Encourage your neighbors to follow suit as there are programs and projects by both the state and federal government to reduce wood waste from entering our landfills. The reduction of wood waste being landfilled is the goal.

TRUCKS

Trucks and trailers that haul debris to the landfill must be hydraulically lifted. **(No Winch Trucks and Trailers Allowed)**

CHRISTMAS TREES

Christmas trees can be dropped at compost sites 3 & 7 from **January 1st - January 15th**.

RECYCLING

There are several options available to the citizens of Minot for recycling. You should check the Yellow Pages for names and telephone numbers or the city of Minot's website.

MINOT LANDFILL

The City of Minot Landfill is located one mile west of Valley Marine on 20th Avenue SW.

All loads shall be enclosed or covered with a tarp so the contents of the load stay within the transporting vehicle.

All waste loads are subject to random inspections. These inspections consist of unloading the vehicle and physically going through the contents of the load while the hauler waits until the inspection has been completed. All unacceptable waste shall be loaded back onto the transporting vehicle and become the property of the hauler.

LANDFILL FEES

With the proper photo ID and current City of Minot Water Bill, Household quantities of waste will be accepted at no charge. No contractors, no contract vehicles, no dump body trucks or contractor trailers.

LANDFILL

We have separate areas for trees, yard waste, appliances, tires, inert waste, building material and household waste. The attendant will direct you to the proper disposal area. The landfill is open Monday through Saturday with the following hourly schedule. Please allow yourself plenty of time to unload.
