- I wish there was more of an effort to welcome people into the community and convey the idea that all are welcome here. It's rough being a minority in terms of gender identity, race/ethnicity, religion, or political views. Just last week an old white guy heckled me for wearing a mask in a public building. As soon as we can retire we are leaving because it's exhausting living here.
- I would like to see a recycling program., Need to have more programs to engage youth and young adults.
- If we pay for trash pickup twice a week, then we should receive that service. Too many times, the schedule falls on a Monday for a holiday. and No recycling please.
- Implement curbside recycling and composting. Invest in active transit (walking/biking) and quality of local neighborhoods.
- Improve homeless shelters and awareness of them, focus less on LGBTQ
- Improved drug enforcement, jail time for drug dealers
- It is frustrating during the winter months to see how much salted sand is used or liquid deice product. I believe there is plenty experienced equipment operators available to use as over hires during this period. It would reduce accidents and prevent unsightly city streets. I do not agree with the city's attempts to fund failing businesses. For example the Port of Minot. If it is a viable project, private money should fund it.
- Less harassment on city buses. Less bars and more family oriented events. Get buses for public schools.
